IN 2022 WE were awarded 108 new projects and worked on 181 projects in 60 different countries. Our business generated a turnover of EUR 27 million.

The biggest individual projects in year 2022 were Forestry and Value chains development programme in Tanzania and Finland's Support to the Ukrainian School Reform. Both were financed by the Ministry for Foreign Affairs of Finland.

GEOGRAPHICALLY OUR STRATEGIC focus was in Africa, Asia, and Eastern Europe.

IN 2023 WE continue to implement our 2021–24 long-term strategy contributing to the Sustainable Development Goals of Agenda 2030. Paving the way for a modernized agriculture in Pakistan

Challenge to be met

Punjab is a major contributor to Pakistan's economy and food security. However, most of the agriculture produce in Punjab, as with the rest of Pakistan, travels through a complex marketing chain with poor regulation and enforcement of rules. There is a need to modernize agricultural marketing systems in Punjab to promote economic growth and job creation.

Aim and impact of our assignment

The proposed project will finance the development of a modern holistic wholesale agriculture market in Lahore and prepare a master plan for development of wholesale markets in other locations proposed and agreed with the Punjab Agriculture Department (PAD). It will complement and enhance the impact of other ongoing government-run as well as other donor-funded projects aimed at improving agriculture value chains. The project will also make recommendations on up to three priority sites for developing other wholesale agriculture markets at Okara, Dera Ghazi Khan, and Rawalpindi in Punjab.

FCG has been contracted by the ADB to conduct the due diligence in terms of technical, financial and economic, social, environmental, and institutional aspects and prepare project feasibility studies to meet the requirements of ADB and the Government of Punjab, Pakistan. Climate change, sustainability and gender mainstreaming are important factors considered and incorporated in the design of ensuing projects.

Strengthening forest value chains in Tanzania

Challenge to be met

In Tanzania, the natural forests and woodlands are threatened by illegal logging and unsustainable use, leading to deforestation and loss of biodiversity. FORVAC promotes sustainable use and value chains in natural forests and woodlands.

Aim and impact of our assignment

Capacity building and policy development work is implemented at regional and central levels in the country, while practical field work is focused on Tanga, Lindi and Ruvuma. Working closely with local enterprises and communities, FORVAC develops forest-based value chains inducing growth in local economies, while at the same time fostering local ownership of forests and facilitating community-based forest management (CBFM). The Programme also supports government institutions in developing their legal and policy framework to improve forest governance and promote sustainable forest resources management.

The support at field level is addressed to producer groups within target villages, as well as encouraging responsible private sector involvement in any parts of these value chains. FORVAC works with individuals and families, communities, traders and private companies to increase economic, social and environmental benefits from forests and woodlands for around 330,000 beneficiaries.

Supplying uninterrupted safe water to residents of South Tarawa

Challenge to be met

Water management in Kiribati is amongst the most complex and challenging in the world. This is not only because of the pressures on the physical resource itself in terms of water quality and quantity, but also because of the increasing social pressures applied to the resource coupled with topographical and spatial constraints. Water resources are fragile, and vulnerable to drought, over-extraction, and contamination. This is further complicated by issues of land ownership and water rights, and in the urban area of South Tarawa, a rapidly increasing population.

Aim and impact of our assignment

FCG has designed (PDA phase) and is now supervising the implementation (PIA Phase) of STWSP that is committed to supplementing the existing water supply to address shortages by constructing climate-resilient and low-carbon water supply infrastructure including desalination plants and an expanded and modernized water supply network, as well as a solar photovoltaic power plant. The capacity of the implementing agencies to effectively manage water supply infrastructure is increased. Awareness of water, sanitation, and hygiene practices and climate change issues is raised by campaigns. Finally, the project will improve the public health and sanitation by offering an opportunity for all residents of South Tarawa to have access to safe water.

Strengthening the capacity of the National Designated Authority (NDA) of the Solomon Islands to Engage with the Green Climate Fund

Challenge to be met

The Solomon Islands is vulnerable to extreme rainfall events, sea-level rise and other effects of climate change. While international funding to tackle these issues is increasingly available, a better awareness and understanding of the financier’s requirements are needed to access the funding and implement climate change adaptations measures. This readiness project focuses on strengthening the Solomon Islands’ capacity to access GCF climate finance and tackle the impacts of climate change.

Aim and impact of our assignment

Readiness and Preparatory Support project targets strengthening country capacity; strengthening stakeholder engagement; strengthening strategies for a national entity to gain direct access accreditation with the GCF; development of projects for preparation of concept notes and proposals for the submission to the GCF; and commencing mobilisation of the Solomon Islands’ Private Sector to engage in climate finance activities. As a result, the Solomon Islands are better prepared to access GCF climate finance to respond to the serious threats from climate change. GCF funding can support the country to raise and realise their ambitions towards low-emissions, climate-resilient pathways, through both mitigation and adaptation activities.

Visible Outcomes and Excellent Reputation Lead to Mutual Trust Among Partners

Challenge to be met

RVWRMP operated in a very remote, mountainous area, with very little access to clean water, toilets, electricity or fresh vegetables. For much of the implementation period there was no local government system (until elections in 2017), there was discrimination against women (especially when menstruating) and disadvantaged castes and ethnicities.

Aim and impact of our assignment

RVWRMP demonstrated capacity to institutionalise learning long term, which eventually translated to a strong local reputation and functional, trusting relationships between the project and its implementation partners, different levels of government and beneficiaries. The project applied a human-rights based approach and was guided by the principles of gender equality and social inclusion. Involvement and empowerment of all, including women and all castes and ethnicities, increased community respect toward the project, improved the sense of genuine ownership at local levels, and strengthened sustainability and capacity to manage rural development.

Among many other tangible achievements, the three phases of the project benefited 635 222 people with water supply, 122 831 with irrigation and 28 635 with electricity from sustainable sources. Furthermore, 236 423 people benefited from improved smokeless and energy saving cooking stoves, and 497 312 from home gardens.

Supporting Seychelles Financial Intelligence Unit

Challenge to be met

Seychelles Financial Intelligence Unit (FIU) wanted to re-inforce capacity to be in a better position to meet its national and international obligations and improve its reporting at international instances such as the Financial Action Task Force (FATF) through its FATF-Style Regional Body (FSRB) (ESAAMLG), the Egmont Group, the International Monetary Fund, the Organisation for Economic Co-operation Development, the European Union, and World Bank.

Aim and impact of the assignment

To help the FIU reach the targets, FCG developed procedures, mechanisms and methodologies for receipt, analysis and dissemination of intelligence reports derived from financial information. FCG assisted the FIU in identifying statistical data patterns for promotion of proactive disclosures and developing reports that speak to the issues thereby driving policy. An effective, official PPP mechanism was also established through a national money laundering forum. A capacity building programme was developed to train the staff within the core function of the FIU. Internal mechanisms to promote domestic cooperation and exchange of information between FIU and LEAs were set up, leading to detection and prosecution of ML and associated offences. An operations review of all units within the FIU was conducted and a proposition of a business process reorganisation was made.

Promoting civil society's cooperation with the police in Albania

Challenge to be met

Albania has been recognized as a potential country for EU membership. However, the country needs to work on re-forming certain areas, particularly regarding the rule of law. Albania has embarked into a profound justice reform that touches upon all rule of law enforcement institutions with the assistance of international partners. The country hopes to work on showcasing its readiness for full EU membership.

Aim and impact of our assignment

The second phase of this Community Policing programme was to build mutual trust and partnership between police and communities in order to create safe neighbourhoods. The project supports three pillars: i) Support to Target Regional Police Directorates, ii) Strategic Management support, and iii) Domestic Violence.

As part of the programme, a Grant Scheme of approximately €500,000 was created to finance Civil Society Organizations' projects promoting their cooperation with the police with respect to community policing. Over the years, 6 rounds of grants have been implemented and 73 projects were awarded in 11 regions of Albania. The grant scheme proved to be efficient in bringing the communities and police closer, raising awareness on topics that concerned the community, and improving the safety of communities.

Finland’s Support to the Ukrainian School Reform

Challenge to be met

Challenges in quality and relevance of education in Ukraine are related to challenges in the curriculum and teaching practices, low competence and status of teachers. The curriculum has been outdated and students tend to lack essential skills meeting the needs of the 21st century. The Education Law and the New Ukrainian School reform aim to address these challenges with support of FCG.

Aim and impact of our assignment

Despite the ongoing war in Ukraine, our Learning Together project continues to support the national education reform and roll it out to Grade 5 and pilot it in Grade 6. Our committed group of teacher trainers in the in-service teacher training institutes and universities keep on benefitting from a series of our thematic webinars and digital training materials, which are based on current priority needs: psychosocial support to teachers and children, mentoring of teachers and teacher students, and ICT in pedagogy. The teacher trainers and the teachers trained by them are being equipped with knowledge and practical tools for self-help and how to best support children’s well-being and learning in the context of education in emergencies.

The Covid-19 first taught us to use and trust the online means and resources. Air raids and power outages have now taught us to use generators and video record all webinars for asynchronous participation. School education and the education reform are continuing with support of the dedicated Ukrainian teachers.

Evaluating EU’s Integrated Border Management programme

Challenge to be met

The Financier (EU), wanted to know how any current and future EU Budget Support programmes could be improved, and required the services of an independent and objective evaluation team to review how well the programmes meet their objectives and the requirements set to them.

Aim and impact of the assignment

This evaluation provided the relevant services of the European Union and the interested stakeholders with an overall independent assessment of the past performance of the Sector Reform Contract in Integrated Border Management. Particular attention was paid to measuring the results against its expected objectives and the reasons underpinning such results. The evaluation also paid attention to other modalities, in order to assess the complementarity and synergy (or discrepancy) of these modalities with budget support. The effects of the budget support operation on the M&E systems in the sectors supported by the programme were also assessed.

The project was anchored on Serbia’s status as EU accession candidate, underpinned by relevant agreements which include the voluntary alignment of Serbia towards the priorities of the EU acquis in the area of Integrated Border Management (IBM).

Reinventing Mauritius as a luxury product hub

Challenge to be met

Mauritius aims to position itself as a hub for luxury products, involving the design and production of exclusive, refined, and unique luxury items for global luxury brands and outlets. To reach this goal, awareness about the level of readiness of Mauritius for developing a luxury cluster in line with international best practices must be created.

Aim and impact of the assignment

FCG helped to develop a roadmap and an implementation plan to expand the export basket and to position Mauritius as a destination for luxury products manufacturing. The project aimed to convince manufacturers to invest their time and money into upgrading their enterprise into one which is in a position to manufacture premium and luxury products and to be competitive.

During this project FCG built a strong positioning strategy for the Mauritius luxury cluster in niche markets and assisted in the development of high-end/luxury products for selected export-ready manufacturing enterprises. Concept Design was prepared for a high-end product e-catalogue including story telling of selected items. Shared understanding of the high-end and luxury product market was created and the capacity building in luxury product development was initiated. Linkages with key target markets for the luxury cluster were also developed.

Improving road infrastructures in Liberia

Challenge to be met

Bad road conditions are a major constraint to economic growth and development in Liberia. The mileage of paved road is limited, and the unpaved road network has deteriorated over the years due to the lack of sustained maintenance. Poor road conditions, especially in rural Liberia, are increasing transportation fares, vehicle maintenance costs, and compromise food production.

Aim and impact of our assignment

The project aims to improve opportunities for poor people to enhance their living conditions and livelihoods by providing them with sustainable road access. This involves improved road accessibility, which enables small-scale farmers to market their agricultural production, facilitates all year-round social service delivery, particularly in the health and education sectors, and creates income earning opportunities for young men and women in rural areas.

So far, the impacts of the project include the following:

- 271 km of feeder road has been rehabilitated, and 800 km of feeder road will be maintained
- Construction of 220 km of Footpath to Track (F2T)
- Construction of several bridges up to 36 meters long
- 200 people were trained in different kind of tasks
- Assisting with the decentralization of road management into three central county administrations
